4. Conductors Update - Jon Knights

Inclement Weather Call - discussion on this procedure and who should make the decision. Lorna will ask Gord if he will do it again this year.

Concert – Order of Bands playing is done – last band will be rotated each time except Green Band.

Survey – Decision was made to have 30 minutes of skills training in sectionals starting in March. **Grants** – Discussion on possible uses for the grant money.

- We have large instruments that are not being used. When we buy new ones we should buy plastic instruments which are easier for seniors.
- -We need grant money for music in order to build a library. There is some money now for each conductor to buy music.
- considering a pilot theory workshop for Green Band or entire band. With enough money we could do this with everyone. Rhythm is a stumbling block for all bands.

Guest Conductors – We have two clinicians booked for the next two weeks, to conduct each band for most of the practice time. They are Colin Clark and David Lum, both from Toronto, and well recommended. They will have lunch after and discussion with the conductors.

Reduce time of the concert – Discussion that we could eliminate O Canada from the concert which would save 3-4 minutes. It was decided to do that.

Winter Term and Winterlude - Winter term is mid-January to end of February followed by Winterlude. The conductors are okay with the terms as last year. The sectionals will start on March 7th

6. New Business

6.1 Survey / Action Plan Committee - Cliff and Bob

Discussion on the length of time needed to complete the Action plan and timing of a follow-up survey. We need a plan for all 5 actions which could take up to 2 years. It was suggested that we wait to do a second survey until Spring 2019 and concentrate on 3 issues.

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Board Actions – some of these are decisions not needing a plan.

- 1. Webpage increase awareness more for public
- 2. Home practice how to motivate people
- 3. Length of major concerts 20% not happy
- 4. Winter term sectionals the conductors
- 5. Raffles, auctions at concerts

Order of Importance was discussed.

- Reinstate Winter term sectionals number of sectionals did not change throughout the term.
- Home practice could become part of the 30 minutes teaching starting in March. Suggestion that practice tips could be sent out by email once a month. Conductors could also give arguments on home practicing and tips on how to practice.

Bob and Cliff will work on an action plan to present to the Board at the next meeting re: to encourage and educate members regarding benefits and methods of practicing at home.

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6.7 New Grant Application - Ideas

Applications for the Ontario Seniors Grant and the City of Peterborough Grant need to be submitted by the end of November. A suggestion was made that we use the Senior's grant money for a specialty band and conductor with a different type of music. Further discussion on a theory workshop which is consistent with what the conductors want. Grants cost PNHB about \$1000 + expenses. Cathy will put a proposal together and consult with the conductors, etc. and work on something.

Discussion on whether or not we should do the Senor's grant at this time. City of Peterborough grant will be submitted. It will allow us to use it for rent, and operating expenses.
